

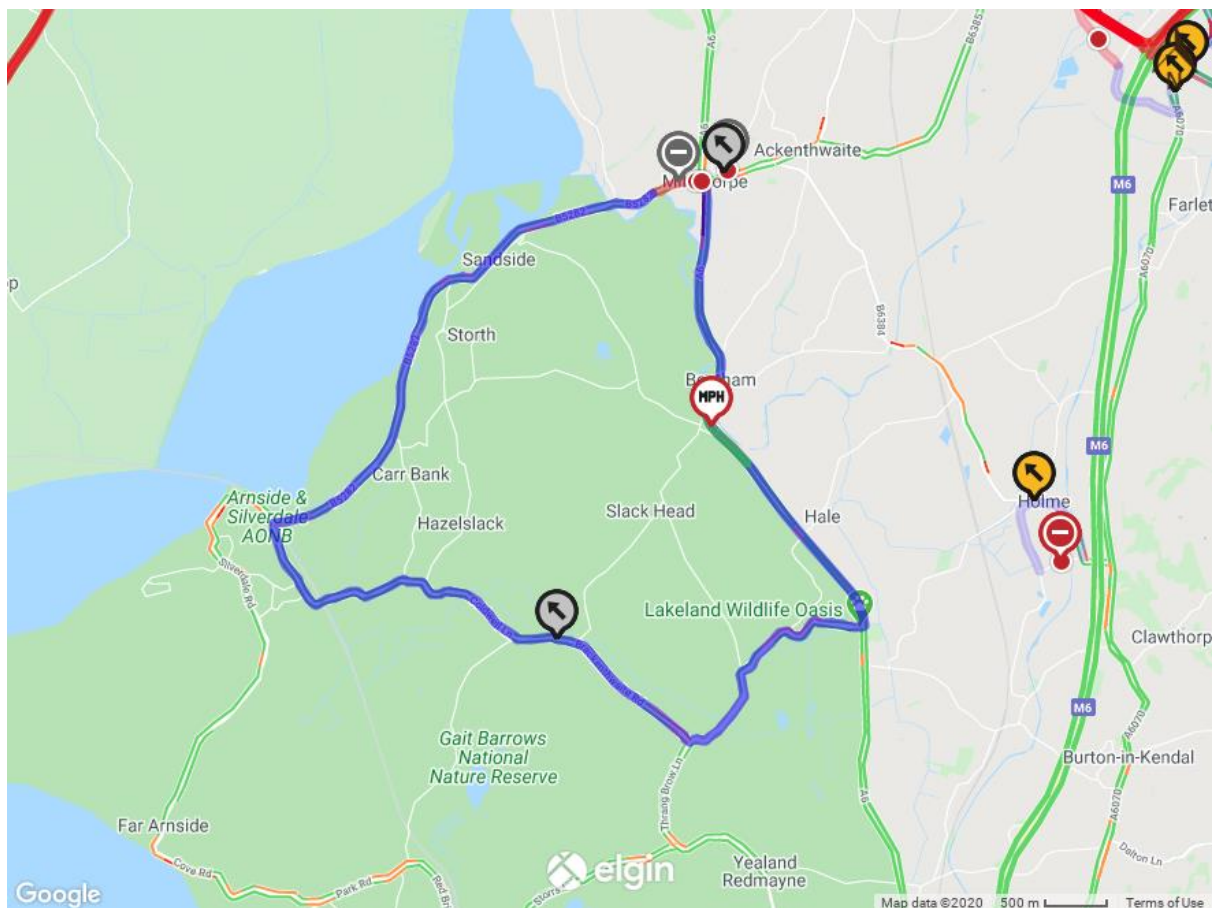
Good Afternoon,

A Reactivation road closure has been put in place to enable Cumbria County Council to carry out surfacing works.

This notice will come into operation on 2nd August 2020 and is expected to remain in place for an approx. duration of 7 nights, between the hours of 18:30 - 01:00 Mon-Fri and 16:30 - 01:00 Sunday.

Location: B5282 Park Road, near Milnthorpe from its junction with the A6 Beetham Road, extending in a westerly direction for approx. 530m.

Alternative Route: A suitable alternative route for vehicles will be signed and available via the unrestricted section of the B5285 Park Road, B5282 Sandside Road, C5097 Black Dyke Road, Coldwell Lane, Brackenthwaite Road, Thrang Brow Lane, C5097 Nineteen Acre Lane, A6 and A6 Beetham Road.

Alternative access arrangements for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists to either end of the closed road will be available on Sunday, with the agreement of Booths Supermarket, via the north side of Park Road and via Booths Supermarket.

A way for pedestrians and dismounted cyclists will be maintained at all times.
